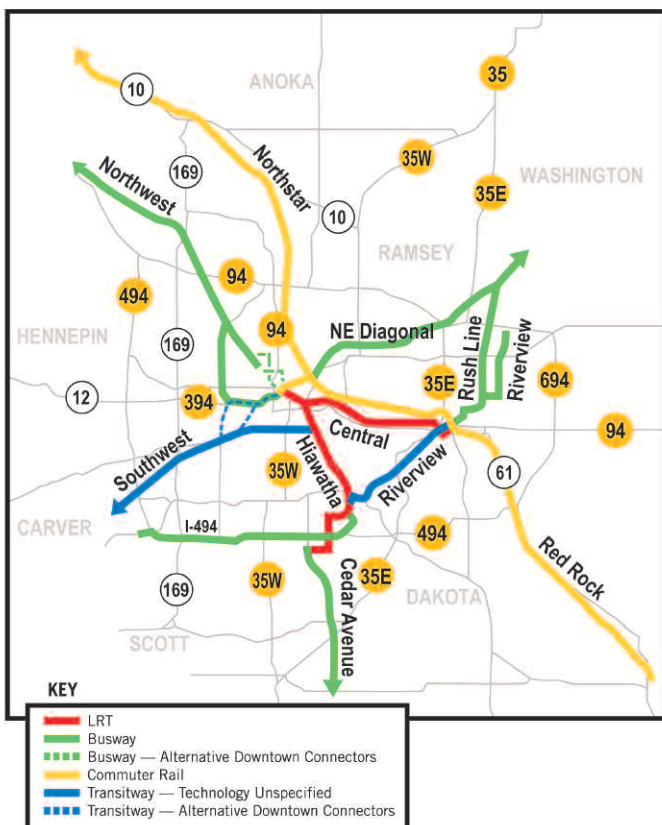
About the Central Corridor Partnership
